Ready4K is an evidence-based family engagement that meets all of the requirements of the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Fund, including those of American Rescue Plan Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ARP ESSER/ESSER III) Fund, which requires LEAs to set aside 20% of funds “to address the academic impact of lost instructional time through the implementation of evidence-based interventions, and ensure that the interventions implemented respond to students’ social, emotional, mental health, and academic needs and address students disproportionately affected by COVID.”
